2nd Annual Georgia Freedom Ride OFFICIAL RIDE RULES

1. How to Enter the Ride

- a. To register for the 2nd Annual Georgia Freedom Ride (the “event”), complete this registration form and return to the address below with your check or log onto www.forgottensoldiers.org and download a registration form.
- b. To register through our web site you may use your Credit/Debit Card using PayPal. When registering on-line please make sure that you notate in the description “2nd Annual Georgia Freedom Ride”. This will ensure your registration is completed and paid for.
- c. You may also register the day of the Event at the Harley Davidson of Cartersville on March 20, 2010, starting at 9am till 11am. Kick Stands up at Noon.
- d. Registration is **\$20 per motorcycle**. If there are two people on a single bike the registration fee is **\$25**.
- e. The fee includes:
 - i. One (1) special edition commemorative t-shirt for the first rider. (The second rider will be able to purchase a t-shirt for a low donation of \$10.)
 - ii. One (1) plate of food for \$5 for each rider

2. Eligibility Restrictions

- a. You must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid license to operate a motorcycle.
- b. The event will take place on Saturday, March 20, 2010 rain or shine.

There will be no refunds of registration fees for any reason.

All riders and passengers must complete registration forms, sign the Ride Release and Waiver and pay for registration before the beginning of the event. To ensure your participation in this event, please bring registration forms along with check for registration fees (**made payable to Forgotten Soldiers Outreach**) to the Harley Davidson of Cartersville on the day of the Event or you can register on-line at www.forgottensoldiers.org and just note that this is for the 2nd Annual Georgia Freedom Ride in the description part.

RELEASE AND WAIVER

The undersigned (on my behalf and on behalf of my heirs, personal representatives, executors, successors and assigns), for and in consideration of the opportunity to engage on Saturday, March 20, 2010 in the Second Annual Georgia Freedom Ride (the "Event") and for other valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, releases and forever discharges the officers, directors, shareholders, employees, agents, representatives of Harley Davidson of Cartersville & Forgotten Soldiers Outreach, Inc., its licensee and its parent subsidiary and affiliated corporations from all liability, including any and all claims, demands, rights and causes of action of any kind whatsoever, known and unknown, whether caused by the negligence of the released parties or otherwise, which I now have or later may have in any way resulting from, or arising out of, directly or indirectly, my participation in the Event.

This Release extends to any and all claims I have or may have against the released parties, even if such claims result from product liability, strict liability or negligence (except willful negligence) on the part of any or all of the released parties concerning the design, manufacture, repair or maintenance of any motorcycle which I will be riding, or concerning the conditions, qualifications, instructions, rules, procedures or conduct under which the Event is constructed, or from any other cause. I understand this to mean that I agree not to sue and waive my right to sue any and all released parties for any injuries resulting to me or to my property during the conduct or, or in connection with the Event and that the released parties shall not be liable for any and all claims for loss, damage or injury of any nature whatsoever to person or property whether caused by the negligent acts of any or all of the released parties or otherwise. However, I do NOT release any party from any claims for intentional misconduct on its part.

I hereby state I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and that I am experienced in and familiar with the operation of various motorcycles. I fully understand the risks and dangers inherent in motorcycling and that the activities of the Event and motorcycling involve the risk of serious bodily injury and/or death. I am licensed to operate a motorcycle. I am voluntarily participating in the Event and I expressly agree to assume the entire risk of any accident or personal injury, including death, which I might suffer as a result of my participating in the Event due to the negligence of the released parties or otherwise. I am in excellent physical and mental health and know of no health-related reason why I cannot fully and safely participate in the Event. I participate in the Event knowing the existing weather conditions, road conditions, and other similar conditions, factors and circumstances associated with the Event may vary and such variance may give rise to any injuries, which I may sustain.

By signing this release, I certify that I have read this release and fully understand it and that I am not relying on any statements or representations of anyone released thereby. I further understand and expressly agree that the foregoing Release and Waiver is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of Georgia and that, if any portion of the Release and Waiver is held invalid, it is agreed that, notwithstanding the invalidity of that portion, the balance of the Release and Waiver shall continue in full legal force and effect.
