Year-Round Letter-Writing Campaign

Attention Teachers:

Have your students apply their writing skills while showing compassion and gratitude to members of our Military.



Our Mission:

How to Write a Letter:

- Include a return address at the top of each letter. Use the teacher's name and school's return address, so the service member may write back.
- Use a generic greeting such as Dear Service Member or Dear American Hero. (We send letters to all branches of the Armed Forces, not just to soldiers in the Army.)
- The body of the letter must be positive and upbeat. Here are some suggestions:
 - Tell about yourself. (school, grade, sports, hobbies)
 - Tell about a positive current event. (field trip, birthday)
 - Ask a question. (What branch of the service are you in? Where are you stationed?)
 - Give a compliment. (Thank you for serving our country. You are very brave.)
- Close the letter with the student's FIRST NAME only.

Teachers:

- ✓ All letters will be proof-read by volunteers at FSO, so please do not put letters into individual envelopes.
- ✓ Artwork is greatly appreciated, but please do not use glitter.
- ✓ Bring letters to the nearest drop-off location. For a list, go to www.forgottensoldiers.org/help/drop-off-locations. Otherwise, mail them to:
