There will also be Wreath presentations by local organizations and individuals, as well as a special presentation of the Wreath of Honor by Vietnam War Veterans, Vini Conigliaro and Deborah Zukero and the infamous dove release. The National Anthem and God Bless America performed by Haileigh Galloway. There will be complimentary food and beverages following the service.
